PRIOR TO PARTICIPATING

All incoming freshmen desiring to participate in any sport must:

1. Secure an athletic information packet from the athletic office at LVHS. (\$25 Cash or money order, no checks please.)
2. Complete & return entire packet including physical and insurance coverage information to athletic office.

The \$25 charge for the packet will cover the cost for student athletic expenses as well as the CCSD mandated concussion management Impact testing. In the packet you will find information and release forms which must be fully completed with the information requested, and will require signatures of both the athlete and a parent/guardian.

Packets may be purchased in the LVHS athletic office beginning May 26, 2009. Please visit the LVHS website for more information.

PHYSICALS

All Athletes must have a physical on record prior to participation in any sport. Per NIAA Guidelines, athletic physicals will be valid for 2 years unless an athlete is injured while participating.

FRESHMEN ELIGIBILITY

Las Vegas High School athletics follows the guidelines set by the Clark County School District and the Nevada Interscholastic Activities Association (NIAA).

All incoming freshmen are eligible to participate in sports at Las Vegas High School. Eligibility checks are sent to the teachers every three weeks. Students must be passing all classes with a 2.0 GPA to maintain eligibility.

SEASON PASSES

You may purchase a family season athletic pass for \$60 for the fall season and/or the winter/spring season. The pass gives free admission for 6 immediate family members to enter all CCSD athletic events with the exception of Bishop Gorman home games and post-season playoff and championship events. Remember, this is not an annual pass. You must purchase a pass for each athletic season.
